The Scholarship will be based upon the following criteria:

- Graduating senior enrolled in the Machine Shop or Pre-Engineering CTE program your senior year.
- Enrolled full time for the upcoming fall semester at a college or trade school. If selected for the scholarship, be able to provide proof of enrollment with student ID number.
- Have a C or better grade average in your ISD CTE program
- The Red Cross and Upper Edge programs rely on volunteers to save lives and build future leaders of tomorrow. All scholarship applications will be considered, but preference given to students who have participated in volunteer activities during their high school years.

How to Apply:

- Complete the ISD online application and print it.
- Along with the application, submit a one page essay that includes why you deserve this scholarship, and your activities and accomplishments.
- Submit application and essay to any staff person in Student Services. You will be given a receipt verifying that your application and essay were submitted on time.

If you apply for a scholarship, it is expected that you be present at the spring ISD awards program where scholarships are presented. If selected for the scholarship, a thank you letter to the scholarship sponsors is required.

The deadline for scholarship applications submission is **3:00 p.m. on FRIDAY, APRIL 7, 2017.**
