



Bay College Scholarship Criteria (10) \$500 Scholarships

For Students in Delta & Schoolcraft Counties

The scholarship program for students participating in career technical education student organizations will once again be offered by Bay College. Scholarships will be awarded mid April so local schools can recognize the students at their award ceremonies.

The Scholarship will be based upon the following criteria:

- Only seniors can be considered for the Bay Scholarship.
- Students must be a paid member of a student organization (Educators Rising, HOSA, SkillsUSA).
- Students must have competed in the U.P. Regional competitions during the students senior year.
- The Bay Scholarships are for the fall semester only.
- An overall high school grade point average (GPA) of 2.5.
- Be accepted to Bay College for the fall semester. Must have Bay Student ID number indicating acceptance to Bay College on scholarship application.
- An essay with a maximum length of one page is to accompany the application. The essay should include your accomplishments, involvements, honors, personal achievements, future goals, etc.

The scholarships awarded must be used by the recipient for the next fall semester. Scholarships cannot be saved for future semesters. Therefore, please be sure that your students applying for the scholarships are absolutely positive they will attend Bay this fall as scholarships cannot be transferred. This would mean another student will lose an opportunity to receive a Bay College Scholarship.

The Bay Scholarship Program will recognize the following areas:

- Content – The student should address the appropriate criteria in the essay.
- Appearance – Neatness, completeness – no blanks.
- Grammar – Essay should be correct to form.
- Spelling – No spelling errors on application or essay.
