



Delta County Sportsmen's Off-Road Vehicle Association (SORVA) Scholarship - \$500

Delta County SORVA is a group of local people who enjoy riding ORVs like 4-wheelers and side-by-sides throughout Upper Michigan. They provide safety classes, develop and maintain trails for public use, serve as a resource for trail system maps and regulations, and promote responsible and courteous riding while having fun on the trails.

Owners of ORVs rely on skilled professionals to keep their machines in good running condition, weld their trailers, administer medical care, and provide services taught in all technical education programs. They would like to support an I.S.D. Career and Technical Education (CTE) student with a \$500 scholarship.

Criteria

- Graduating senior enrolled in any I.S.D. CTE program your senior year.
- Enrolled full time for the upcoming fall semester at a college, trade school, or apprenticeship program. If selected for the scholarship, be able to provide proof of enrollment with Student ID number.
- Have a B or better grade average in your I.S.D. CTE program.
- Preference will be given to students who have participated in off-road vehicle (ORV) recreation activities, but all applications will be considered.
- Your application and essay will be evaluated on class performance, attendance, attitude, involvement in school and community activities, and work experience.

How to Apply

- Complete the I.S.D. online application.
- Along with the application, submit a one page essay that includes why you deserve this scholarship, your activities and accomplishments, and any involvement (if any) in ORV activities.
- Submit application and essay to any staff person in Student Services. You will be given a receipt verifying that your application was submitted on time.
- Deadline for application and essay is Friday, April 7, 2017.
