## STUDENT OF THE YEAR SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

The Hampton/Ryan Achievement Award was established in honor of Joseph Hampton and Ivan Ryan for their efforts in initiating vocational programming in the Delta-Schoolcraft Intermediate School District. It was through the efforts of these men that the opportunity for hands-on vocational training became a reality to Delta and Schoolcraft County young men and women.

The Hampton/Ryan Achievement Award is presented annually to one student of vocational education for outstanding achievement in the classroom as a student and individual. Nominations are based upon distinguished performance in vocational skills, leadership, and personal development as witnessed by the students, instructors, administrators and employers.

One student from each section of CTE classes maybe nominated for Student of the Year by the instructor of that class. All nominees will write a one page essay and complete the scholarship application submitting both by the designated deadline note on the application form. All nominees will go through an interview with persons from the community who will select the Student of the Year. The number one ranked Student of the Year will be deemed Student of the Year and receive the Hampton-Ryan Scholarship.

### Selection Criteria

All SOY nominees will complete a scholarship application, write a one page essay and participate in the interview process. Juniors and seniors are eligible for nomination, but ONLY seniors can be awarded the Hampton-Ryan Scholarship.

Nominees are judged on:

- Leadership Potential
- Attitude
- Achievement and Involvement (awards and activities)
- Attendance
- Community and School Development
- Identified Career Goals
- Class Participation and Performance
- Cooperation
- Responsibility

**NOTE:** Nominees are solely responsible for submitting a completed application and essay hand delivering them to the CTE Student Services office by the designated deadline noted on the application form.

The committee will make the selection based upon the information the student supplies in the application and essay, and during the interview.
