

Schoolcraft County - Student of the Year

RULES

Juniors and seniors may be nominated for Student of the Year but only seniors can win the overall Student of the Year Award and Hampton/Ryan Scholarship. Instructors will nominate one student per section for Student of the Year. Every student nominated for Student of the Year who completes the proper application and essay will receive a Student of the Year plaque and recognition. Senior Student of the Year nominees will also go through an interview that will be the final step to being selected Student of the Year. The decision of the interview team is final in this selection.

A **one page** essay and completed application are required by all students nominated. The essay should include your accomplishments, involvements, honors, personal achievements, future goals, etc. Computers are available in the MOIS Lab or Student Services office for student use to type their essay. Office staff will not assist students in writing their essay. Essays over one page in length will be disqualified. The delivery of the essay is the sole responsibility of the nominee and must be received at the student services office by the deadline noted on the application.

An **interview** of the senior Student of the Year nominees will be scheduled. This is the final step to being selected Student of the Year. The decision of the interview team is final. The Student of the Year will be awarded at the Student Awards Banquet.

Emphasis will be placed upon:

- Content:** The student should address the criteria listed above, i.e., including what career goals have been set.
- Appearance:** Neatness, completeness.
- Grammar:** Essay should be correct to form.
- Spelling:** No spelling errors on application or essay.

Essay, and scholarship application must be received at the Student Services Office by *Friday, April 7, 2017.*
